The current industrial relations context within which disability and community services operate is a complex and ever-changing environment. The introduction of the Social, Community, Home Care and Disability Services Industry Award (the modern SACS Award) as well as the Equal Remuneration Case currently being deliberated by Fair Work Australia has created an environment of expectation for change for the disability and community services sector.

To support NGOs, NDS together with ADHC, Jobs Australia and the Australian Services Union will be hosting Regional Information and Education Forums. These forums will be held across NSW and will provide information and discussion on Award Modernisation and the Equal Remuneration Case for the disability and community services sector.
