The school counsellor will contribute to College initiatives, including professional development and critical incident response, as required.

The successful applicant will be offered the opportunity to continue their professional growth in a supportive environment and enjoy school based working conditions.

**QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:**

The successful applicant will have a practical commitment to the Vision and Mission of Catholic education; have tertiary qualifications in Social Work, Psychology, or related disciplines; Eligibility for membership of an appropriate professional association (e.g. AASW, APS or CAPA). Experience working with adolescents/young people is essential, preferably in a secondary school setting.
