Resilience Building for Emergency Responses

The Resilience Building for Emergency Responses project is supporting bottom-up approaches to the current (and future) crises and ensuring that top-down emergency responses better align with context and need.

In Phase 1, the project is engaging to support small and medium-sized NGO service providers in areas most impacted by the current COVID-19 emergency to identify and resolve emerging issues, provide a feedback loop between the social services sector and government, and help ensure appropriate interfaces and referral pathways are in place.

Phase 2 of the project will document lessons learned during Phase 1 and other recent disasters and develop resources to support organisations to build resilience and assist them to respond to future adverse events.

Symposium on innovation and service transformation

The symposium will bring together organisations from the social services, justice and health sectors to reflect on the impact of the Social Sector Transformation Fund (SSTF) and showcase outcomes. It will provide a forum for celebrating new knowledge and innovation and for dialogue on service transformation in NSW.

The symposium will run over two days and be a mix of practical workshops and interactive sessions to share knowledge, learnings and the impact of SSTF on service delivery. It will be held in the third quarter of 2022.
